It should be an objective of the performance industries to embrace diversity and strive to promote equality for all people, regardless of their sex, race, colour, ethnic or social origin, genetic features, religion or belief, political opinion, membership of a national minority, disability, age, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression.

The International Federation of Actors (FIA) strongly supports equal rights and opportunities and firmly rejects any form of discrimination that directly or indirectly may adversely affect the working lives of performers.

FIA acknowledges that marriage equality would make a material difference to many of its members' professional lives and supports them in the context of the debates currently taking place in many countries around the world, in particular in Australia and in Northern Ireland.

The Federation stands with LGBTQI+ performers and looks forward to the day when all performers are treated equally under law.
